My practice focuses on sensor-augmented instruments, gesture-driven systems, and browser-based environments for real-time musical interaction. Recent projects include *NIHCI*, a non-intrusive framework design and interface for trombone performance; *Sonic Time Machine*, a UNESCO-endorsed permanent sound-heritage installation; and *MIDImyFACE*, a web-based facial-gesture controller.
